Fundraisers - Recaps and New Events

Tag Day was a huge success! In just four hours, 19 kids collected more than \$1,000.00 for the band! Another Tag Day has been scheduled for Monday, August 6th, 6:00 pm - 8:30 pm. Mr. Roderer has made this a scheduled event for all band members. Parents are needed to chaperone and provide transportation.

Entertainment Books will be available beginning August 13th. The books sell for \$20.00 each and make great gifts. The boosters keep \$8.00 from each book sold. Our goal this year is to sell 500. For every band member that sells more than 5 books, the member will be able to apply the \$8.00 per book profit directly toward their band fees. A rep from the entertainment book company will be holding a short meeting for the kids on August 7th to discuss some of the great selling incentives they are offering.

The Lions concession stand at Mills Road Park football field will be our fundraiser for August 5th and 19th. The concessions booth at the Lions Park made \$1,900.00. This amount will be split with us after the Lions deduct their cost for expenses.

Market Day will not deliver our order if it is under \$1,000.00. Please place your order and ask a friend to do the same to keep this fundraiser alive!

Bagging at bigg's will again be on the fundraising calendar later this year. We will be working two consecutive Saturdays. Dates will be announced later.

A cocktail / "meet & greet" fundraiser is being planned at The Madison in Covington. They have agreed to donate the space for the event, servers and decorations. The boosters will be responsible for paying for the food. A silent auction and raffles are being planned. Tickets will be \$15.00 each or \$25.00 per couple. The goal will be to sell 250 tickets. Q102 is on board with us on this one and has agreed to sponsor the event and promote it on the air! The event will take place sometime in September.

Our Max & Erma's fundraiser earned a total of \$203.00. They have invited us back and another date will be planned in the fall.
